- Turn in **Senior Quote** NOW if you have not already done so. Last chance is this week.
- All seniors are asked to bring in a baby picture for the Senior Slideshow. The Slideshow is shown at Baccalaureate and even if you are not purchasing a senior DVD, **all seniors are asked to turn in a baby picture!**
- Turn in baby picture to Mrs. Worsham April 22 – May 2.
- Mrs. Worsham has order forms if you want to order a **Senior DVD**. The DVD includes prom, slideshow, and graduation. The cost is **\$25 CASH ONLY**. Pay and order from Mrs. Worsham. Orders and money due May 17.
- Senior **cap and gowns** will be given out **Friday, May 3, IF YOU HAVE CLEARED ALL DEBT!** This includes lunchroom and library books used for senior research paper.
- **Senior debt** should be paid by **May 1, CASH or MONEY ORDER ONLY**. No checks!
- **Baccalaureate practice** will be **Friday, May 17, at 8:00 a.m.** YOU MUST COME TO PRACTICE if you want to participate in Baccalaureate. (HCCA students will have to miss HCCA classes if they wish to participate)
- **Baccalaureate service** is **Sunday, May 19, at 2:00 p.m.** in the AHS Auditorium. Senior Slideshow plays at this time. Dress in Sunday attire. Wear cap and gown. **Seniors should be in the AHS library by 1:15.**

- **Graduation Practice is at the Dothan Civic Center on Thursday, May 23 at 4:45 pm.** This is dress rehearsal, dress as you will for graduation. Graduation pictures will be taken at this time. If you arrive late, after we have already started, you will be asked to leave and you will NOT participate in graduation. Only seniors allowed at practice, NO PARENTS!
- **Graduation is at the Dothan Civic Center on Friday, May 24 and you should arrive no later than 4:45 pm.**
- If you are in alternative school at the time of graduation practice, you will not be allowed to participate. And **if you do not attend graduation practice for any reason - you are not allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony.**

Graduation Dress Attire NO EXCEPTIONS:

Misters: black slacks, black shoes and socks, white button up shirt, dark tie

Misses: black dress that doesn't hang below your gown, nice black shoes, no flops. Be mindful of shoes with too much of a heel. You will be walking across the stage in front of everyone, make sure your shoes are comfortable and you can walk easily in them.

You are not allowed to decorate your cap or gown in any way. No embroidery, patches, monogramming, painting, etc. Only cords or sashes you received at Honors Day are allowed. Jewelry should be simple, only black, white, silver, or gold.
